MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Richard M. Suchar appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Murphy, J.*) ordering Suchar to pay twenty-five dollars per month toward his restitution balance. The court exercised proper jurisdiction over Suchar in this matter. *See Margani v. Sanders*, 453 A.2d 501, 503 (Me. 1982). The court did not commit clear error in determining that Suchar intentionally or knowingly refused to obey the previous restitution order, or that he failed to make a good faith effort to obtain the funds to pay the restitution. *See Gauthier v. State*, 2011 ME 75, ¶ 13, 23 A.3d 185. The remainder of Suchar's claims are without merit.
