## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Wayne M. Robinson appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Machias, *Mallonee, J.*) finding Robinson in contempt, M.R. Civ. P. 66, for failure to protect and turn over to Marie T. Delory property awarded to her by a divorce judgment and ordering Robinson to pay Delory \$470 for the property or, failing such payment, to pay a fine of \$470 to the court on the contempt. On appeal, Robinson contends that he was not responsible for the lost and damaged property and that the property at issue was either not under his control or had been abandoned by Delory. The court reached its decision after a contested hearing. No transcript or alternative statement of the record of the hearing has been provided by Robinson. When there is no transcript of a hearing that is subject to an appeal, we must assume that the facts found in the trial court's judgment and the remedies ordered by the trial court after the hearing are fully supported by the evidence in the record of the hearing. *See Rainbow v. Ransom*, 2010 ME 22, ¶ 3, 990 A.2d 535.
