MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Ronald C. Huber appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Waldo County, *Hjelm, J.*) dismissing Huber's petition for review of the Department of Transportation's grant of a conservation easement to the Maine Coast Heritage Trust on 601 acres of Sears Island land. *See* 5 M.R.S. § 11008(1) (2010); M.R. Civ. P. 80C(m). We affirm the dismissal for lack of standing because Huber has failed to assert any particularized, or direct and personal, injury resulting from the Department's grant of a conservation easement to protect the 601 acres at issue here. *See Lindemann v. Comm'n on Governmental Ethics & Election Practices*, 2008 ME 187, ¶¶ 7-15, 961 A.2d 538, 541-43.
