MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Cynthia J. Trefry appeals from the judgment of the Violations Bureau (Biddeford, *Foster, J.*) finding her to have committed the civil infraction of maintaining a vehicle on a public way with an expired registration, 29-A M.R.S. § 351(1) (2010). On appeal, Trefry contends, in essence, that she disagrees with the law that prohibits and imposes fines for parking a vehicle with an expired registration on a public way. While Trefry may disagree with the law and the fine imposed, she does not dispute that the violation occurred and the available record fully supports the court's finding of a civil violation.
