MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Steve R. Anctil appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Rockland, *Sparaco, J.*) dismissing his complaint pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6). Contrary to Anctil's contentions, the court committed no error by dismissing his complaint, because Anctil failed to state a claim upon which relief could be granted. *See* 14 M.R.S. § 7071 (2016); *Sabina v. JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A.*, 2016 ME 141, ¶¶ 5-6, 148 A.3d 284; *Dep't of Corr. v. Pub. Utils. Comm'n*, 2009 ME 40, ¶¶ 11-12, 968 A.2d 1047.
