MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

William R. Sjostrom Jr. appeals from a protection from abuse order entered by the District Court (Bangor, *Worth, J.*) on a complaint filed by Pat Doe. Contrary to Sjostrom's contention, competent evidence supports the court's findings of abuse, and the court did not clearly err in granting Doe's request for a protection from abuse order. *See Deah v. Cuthbert*, 2018 ME 34, ¶¶ 1, 14, 180 A.3d 1087; 19-A M.R.S. § 4002(1) (2022).
