MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Jessica G. and Kevin M. appeal from a judgment entered by the District Court (Caribou, *Linthicum, J.*) terminating their parental rights to their child. Contrary to the mother's and the father's contentions, the record supports, by clear and convincing evidence, the court's findings as to both grounds of parental unfitness, 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(i), (ii) (2022); *see In re Children of Anthony M.*, 2018 ME 146, ¶¶ 10-11, 195 A.3d 1229; *In re Children of Tiyonie R.*, 2019 ME 34, ¶ 6, 203 A.3d 824, and we discern no error or abuse of discretion in the court's findings or its determination that termination of their parental rights was in the best interest of the child, *see* 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a) (2022); *In re Child of Ronald W.*, 2018 ME 107 ¶¶ 11, 13, 190 A.3d 1029; *see also* 22 M.R.S. § 4050(2) (2022).
