MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Michael W. Bell Sr. appeals from a judgment of conviction of criminal operating under the influence (OUI), 29-A M.R.S. § 2411(1-A)(C)(2) (2024), entered by the trial court (Somerset County, *Mullen, C.J.*), after a jury trial. Viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the State, there is sufficient evidence in the record for a jury to find beyond a reasonable doubt that Bell committed the offense. *See id.*; *State v. Troy*, 2014 ME 9, ¶ 10, 86 A.3d 591.
