MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Central Maine Power Company appeals from an interlocutory order of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Cashman, J.*) denying its motion for summary judgment on Bruce Colfer's negligence claim. We are not persuaded that the judicial economy exception to the final judgment rule applies in this case, and we therefore dismiss the appeal. *See Marcoux v. Parker Hannifin/Nichols Portland Div.*, 2005 ME 107, ¶ 14, 881 A.2d 1138; *Cutting v. Down East Orthopedic Assocs., P.A.*, 2021 ME 1, ¶¶ 14-20, 244 A.3d 226; *Quirion v. Veilleux*, 2013 ME 50, ¶ 9, 65 A.3d 1287.
