MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

David Griffin appeals from the judgment entered in the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Pierson, J.*) following a jury verdict of guilty for operating under the influence, 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2411 (1996); operating without a license, 29-A M.R.S.A. § 1251 (1996); and terrorizing, 17-A M.R.S.A. § 210 (1996). The State amended the indictment on the day of trial to include the name of another police officer as a person allegedly terrorized by Griffin. Contrary to Griffin's contention, this amendment was not a substantial change requiring resubmission to the grand jury. *See* M.R. Crim. P. 7(e); *State v. Flick*, 577 A.2d 1192, 1193-94 (Me. 1990).
