MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Jason Rocque appeals from a judgment of conviction entered in the Superior Court (Kennebec, *Studstrup, J.*) on his conditional plea of no contest to heroin trafficking, in violation of Title 17-A M.R.S.A. § 1103 (1983 & Supp. 1997). Contrary to Rocque's contentions, the court did not err by its denial of his motion to suppress statements made incident to his being stopped by an officer of the Maine State Police and all physical evidence, including the heroin, obtained after the stop. *See State v. Gullick*, 2000 ME 170, ¶ 13.
