MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Kaylee H., Herbert H. III, and Kameron H. appeals from the judgment of the District Court (South Paris, *Cote, J.*) terminating his parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055 (1992 & Supp. 1999). Contrary to the father's contentions, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's finding that he is unable to protect the children from jeopardy; that he will not be able to take responsibility for the children within a time that is reasonably calculated to meet the children's needs; and that termination is in the children's best interests.
