MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Merlin Knox Jr. appeals from a judgment of conviction entered in the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Kravchuk*, *J.*) finding him guilty of harassment, *see* 17-A M.R.S.A. § 506-A (1983 & Supp. 1999), and violation of a protection from harassment order, *see* 17-A M.R.S.A. § 506-B (1983 & Supp. 1999). Contrary to the defendant's contentions, the evidence rationally supports the defendant's convictions beyond a reasonable doubt. *See State v. Poulliot*, 1999 ME 39, ¶ 15, 726 A.2d 210, 214.
