MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Lacie R., Brittany R., and Tasha R. challenges the sufficiency of the evidence supporting the judgment of the District Court (Rockland, *Anderson, J.*) terminating her parental rights to her three daughters. Contrary to her contentions, the record contains sufficient evidence to support the court's findings that the mother was unable or unwilling to protect her children from jeopardy or take responsibility for them within a timeframe reasonably calculated to meet their needs and that terminations were in the best interest of each child. *See* 22 M.R.S.A. \$\$ 4055(1)(B)(2), (1-A)(E) (1992 & Supp. 1999).
