MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The parents of Doreen H., Heather H., and Susan H. appeal the judgment of the District Court (Rockland, *Westcott, C.J.*) terminating their parental rights. Contrary to the parents' contentions, the record contains sufficient evidence to support the findings of the court that the parents are unable to protect the children from jeopardy and unable to take responsibility for them, within a time reasonably calculated to meet the children's needs, and that termination is in the best interests of the children. *See* 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a) & (1)(B)(2)(b)(i) (1992). Furthermore, the District Court did not abuse its discretion in admitting certain testimony of the Department's witnesses.
