#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

James W. Vogt appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (York County, *Perkins, A.R.J.*) affirming the decision of a Department of Human Services hearing officer that established Vogt's net child support debt and net credit for his children's medical expenses for the period between August 13, 1993, and January 6, 1998. Contrary to Mr. Vogt's contentions, the hearing officer did not abuse his discretion or commit an error of law. *See Sabattus School Comm. v. Dept. of Educ.*, 644 A.2d 1380, 1382 (Me. 1994). Moreover, substantial evidence supported the hearing officer's findings. *See id.*
