MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Sadie G. appeals from a child protective order entered in the District Court (Biddeford, *Foster*, *J.*) pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4035(3) (1992). Contrary to the father's contentions, the evidence is sufficient to support the court's findings that the child was in circumstances of jeopardy to her health and welfare, and that the father had subjected other members of Sadie's family to physical, emotional, and sexual abuse. *See In re Thomas B.*, 1998 ME 236, ¶ 2, 719 A.2d 529, 530; *see also* 22 M.R.S.A. § 4035(2) (1992).
