MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Heather C. appeals from the judgment entered in the District Court (Somerset, Clapp, J.) terminating her parental rights, entered pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055 (1992 & Supp. 1999). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the application of 22 M.R.S.A. §§ 4002(1-B)(C) (Supp. 1999) and 4036(1)(G-2) (Supp. 1999), by which the trial court relieved the Department of Human Services of its statutory duty to provide reunification services to the mother, did not violate her rights to due process of law. *See In re Heather C.*, 2000 ME 99, ¶ 32, 751 A.2d 448, 457; 22 M.R.S.A. §§ 4002(1-B)(C), 4036(1)(G-2).
