MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother appeals from the judgment entered in District Court (Farmington, *Mullen, J.*) terminating her parental rights in her daughter Tosha K. Contrary to the mother's contentions, the evidence was sufficiently clear and convincing to support the court's determination that she was unwilling or unable to protect her daughter from jeopardy, and that the termination of her parental rights was in the child's best interests. *See* 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (1992).
