MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kenneth Crawford appeals from his conviction in the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Mead, C.J.*) for arson. 17-A M.R.S.A. § 802(1)(B)(1) (1983 & Supp. 2000). Contrary to Crawford's contention, the evidence, viewed in the light most favorable to the State, was sufficient for the court rationally to have found the element of intent satisfied. *See State v. Turner*, 2001 ME 44, ¶ 6, 766 A.2d 1025, 1027; *State v. Ardolino*, 1997 ME 141, ¶ 20, 697 A.2d 73, 80.
