MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Defendant, Michael Niles, appeals from judgments entered on jury verdicts in the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Marsano, J.*) finding him guilty of one count of illegally baiting deer (Class E), 12 M.R.S.A. § 7458(9) (1994 & Supp. 2000) and two counts of erecting a stand without permission (Class E), 12 M.R.S.A. § 7406(16) (1994 & Supp. 2000). Defendant raises only factual issues on appeal. Because he failed to provide us with a transcript of the trial, he failed to meet his burden of providing us with a sufficient record to allow adequate consideration of those factual issues. *See State v. Butler*, 627 A.2d 530, 531 (Me. 1993); *State v. Thwing*, 487 A.2d 260, 262 (Me. 1985).
