## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

[¶1] Roger McClure appeals from the judgment entered in the District Court (Bangor, *Russell, J.*) following a bench trial finding him guilty of one count of violating a protective order (Class D), 5 M.R.S.A. § 4659(1) (Supp. 2000), and one count of violating a condition of release (Class E), 15 M.R.S.A. § 1092 (Supp. 2000). Contrary to his contentions, the evidence was sufficient to support his convictions, *State v. Deschenes*, 2001 ME 136, ¶ 6, 780 A.2d 295, and the court did not utilize unreliable evidence in sentencing, *State v. Ricker*, 2001 ME 76, ¶ 20, 770 A.2d 1021.
