MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Nancy Burrill appeals from judgments entered in the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Marsano, J.*) affirming judgments of conviction for criminal trespass (Class E), 17-A M.R.S.A. § 402(1)(E) (Supp. 2000), and violation of conditions of release (Class E), 15 M.R.S.A. § 1092 (Supp. 2000), entered in the District Court (Millinocket, *Stitham, J.*). Contrary to Burrill's contentions, the evidence, when viewed in a light most favorable to the State, is more than sufficient to allow the court to have rationally found each element of both charges beyond a reasonable doubt. *See State v. Hayes*, 675 A.2d 106, 109 (Me. 1996).
