MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Lisa Stain appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Humphrey, J.*) following a jury verdict finding her guilty of Class C theft in violation of 17-A M.R.S.A. § 353 (1983). Stain contends that the court erred in allowing a police officer to testify that he prepared a photo line-up containing her photo after checking a license plate number with the Department of Motor Vehicles that was provided by an employee of the store where the theft occurred, and that the evidence was insufficient to support her conviction for Class C theft. Despite Stain's contentions, the court neither erred nor abused its discretion in admitting the testimony, *see State v. Corbin*, 2000 ME 167, ¶ 5, 759 A.2d 727, 729 (quoting *Kay v. Hanover Ins. Co.*, 677 A.2d 556, 558 (Me. 1996)), and the evidence was sufficient to support her conviction. *See State v. Nelson*, 1998 ME 183, ¶ 5, 714 A.2d 832, 833; 17-A M.R.S.A. § 362(3-A) (Supp. 2000).
