MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Grace N.'s father appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (West Bath, *Westcott, J.*) terminating his parental rights. The father's contention that the court, at the termination hearing, erroneously excluded expert testimony concerning interview techniques used during the alleged victims' disclosures of sexual abuse by the father is without merit. The court properly allowed testimony that was relevant to the issue of termination of the father's parental rights, and excluded only that evidence that was irrelevant. *See In re David W.*, 568 A.2d 513, 515 (Me. 1990).
