MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Robert R. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Portland, *Eggert, J.*) terminating her parental rights. Contrary to the mother's contentions, there is sufficient evidence in the record on which the court based its findings by clear and convincing evidence that the mother is unable to protect Robert from jeopardy within a time reasonably calculated to meet his needs, *see* 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(i) (1992); the mother is unable to take responsibility for Robert within a time reasonably calculated to meet his needs, *see* 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(ii) (1992); and termination of the mother's parental rights is in Robert's best interest, *see* 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a) (1992). In addition, the court's application of the rebuttable presumption pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1-A)(D) (Supp. 2000) does not violate the mother's due process rights. *See In re Sarah T.*, 629 A.2d 53, 54-55 (Me. 1993).
