MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Herman Watson appeals from the judgment of the Superior Court (Somerset County, *Mead. C.J.*) affirming the judgment of the District Court (Skowhegan, *Murray*, *J.*) granting a divorce to the parties on the grounds of irreconcilable differences. Contrary to Herman Watson's contentions, the trial court's allocation of the parties' marital property and debt did not "result[] in a plain and unmistakable injustice, so apparent that it is instantly visible without argument." *Kapler v. Kapler*, 2000 ME 131, ¶ 8, 755 A.2d 502, 506 (citation and quotations omitted).
