MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother appeals from an order entered in the District Court (Augusta, *French, J.*) terminating her parental rights and responsibilities with regard to her children, Tylor and Timothy T. Contrary to the mother's contention, the court did not improperly consider the best interests of the children before it found parental unfitness. *See In re Ashley A.*, 679 A.2d 86, 89 (Me. 1996).
