MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Robert G. Costa appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Ellsworth, *Staples, J.*) granting Roberta T. Lichtenger's motion to dissolve a temporary order for protection and dismissing his complaint for protection from abuse. Contrary to Costa's contentions, the court did not exceed the bounds of its discretion when it (1) denied his motion for continuance of the hearing for Lichtenger's motion to dissolve the temporary order for protection, *see* 19-A M.R.S.A. § 4006(7) (1998); *Pelletier v. Pelletier*, 597 A.2d 60, 61 (Me. 1991), and (2) granted Lichtenger her attorney fees, *see* 19-A M.R.S.A. 4007(1)(L) (1998); *Largay v. Largay*, 2000 ME 108, ¶ 16, 752 A.2d 194, 198.
