MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Olin Williams appeals from the judgment of the Superior Court (York County, *Bradford*, *A.R.J.*) issued upon a jury verdict finding him guilty of kidnapping (Class A), 17-A M.R.S.A. § 301(1)(A)(4) (1983); attempting to commit murder (Class A), 17-A M.R.S.A. §§ 152(1), 201(1) (1983); aggravated assault (Class B), 17-A M.R.S.A. § 208(1)(C) (1983); burglary of a motor vehicle (Class C), 17-A M.R.S.A. § 405(1) (Supp. 2001); and eluding an officer (Class C), 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2414(3) (1996). Contrary to Williams's contentions, the Superior Court's jury instruction regarding the definition of restraint was not obvious error, *see State v. Small*, 2000 ME 182, ¶ 5, 763 A.2d 104, 105, and the

evidence was sufficient to support the jury's finding, beyond a reasonable doubt, that he attempted to commit murder, *see State v. Turner*, 2001 ME 44, \P 6, 766 A.2d 1025, 1027.
