MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

David J. Sinclair appeals from the judgment entered in the District Court (Bridgton, *Eggert, J.*) finding him guilty of violating a condition of release (Class E), 15 M.R.S.A. § 1092 (Supp. 2001). Contrary to Sinclair's contentions, the District Court could have rationally concluded beyond a reasonable doubt that he violated the condition of release and had contact with the victim. *State v. Deschenes*, 2001 ME 136, ¶ 6, 780 A.2d 295, 297.
