MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Otto Appelt appeals from a judgment of conviction of criminal mischief (Class D), 17-A M.R.S.A. § 806(1)(A) (Supp. 2001), and two counts of assault (Class D), *id.* § 207(1) (1983), entered on his plea of guilty in Superior Court (York County, *Cole, J.*). Contrary to Appelt's contention, the court did not abuse its discretion in denying his motion to withdraw his guilty plea. *See State v. Lambert*, 2001 ME 113, ¶ 5, 775 A.2d 1140, 1142.
