## MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Shirley E. Adamson appeals from a conviction entered following a jury trial in the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Marden, J.*) of two counts of evasion of Maine income tax (Class C), 36 M.R.S.A. § 5330 (1990); three counts of evasion of Maine income tax (Class D), *id.* § 184-A (Supp. 1999); and five counts of failure to make and file Maine income tax returns (Class D), *id.* § 5332 (1990). Because Adamson has not provided us with a transcript of the proceedings before the trial court or a statement of the evidence pursuant to M.R. App. P. 5(d), we must assume that the record would support the verdict. *See, e.g., State v. Ross,* 1997 ME 67, ¶ 1, 691 A. 2d 1253, 1254.
