MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Bridgette H. and Christopher H. appeals from judgments entered in the District Court (Ellsworth, *Staples, J.*) terminating his parental rights to those children. Contrary to the contentions of the father, the evidence is sufficient to support the court's findings by clear and convincing evidence that the father is unable to protect the children from jeopardy and that the circumstances are unlikely to change within a time reasonably calculated to meet the needs of the children, 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(i) (1992 & Supp. 2001); and that termination of his parental rights is in the best interest of the children, *id.* § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a), *In re Joseph V.*, 500 A.2d 628, 629 (Me. 1985).
