MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Neil Williamson appeals from a judgment of conviction of operating after habitual offender revocation, 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2557(1) (Supp. 2001), entered after trial in District Court (Bridgton, *Eggert, J.*). Williamson challenges the sufficiency of the evidence. Because he has not provided us with a transcript of the proceedings before the trial court, we must assume that there was sufficient evidence to support the conviction. *See State v. Nugent*, 2002 ME 111, ¶ 2, 801 A.2d 1001, 1002.
