MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Christopher Voisine appeals from a judgment entered in Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Studstrup, J.*) after a jury verdict in favor of Lawrence Pray on Voisine's negligence claim arising out of a car-pedestrian accident. Contrary to Voisine's contention, the trial court did not err in instructing the jury on the emergency doctrine. *See Hargrove v. McGinley*, 2001 ME 36, ¶¶ 6-7, 766 A.2d 587, 589-90.
