MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Ray Henderson appeals from a judgment entered after a bench trial in Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Hjelm, J.*) in favor of his ex-wife Ona Henderson on her fraudulent transfer claim. Contrary to Ray's contention, the court did not clearly err in finding by clear and convincing evidence that Ray acted with actual intent to hinder, delay or defraud Ona, *see* 14 M.R.S.A. § 3575(1)(A) (Supp. 2001); *Morin v. Dubois*, 1998 ME 160, ¶ 3, 713 A.2d 956, 957, and acted with malice justifying the imposition of punitive damages, *see Tuttle v. Raymond*, 494 A.2d 1353, 1361 (Me. 1985), when he conveyed the real property on which the marital home was located to his mother in a deed recorded only three days after he filed his divorce complaint. Ray's other arguments on appeal do not merit discussion.
