MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Bradley Anderson appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Beaudoin, J.*) finding that he was speeding in a construction area in violation of 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2075(2) (1996). Anderson contends that the evidence failed to establish that he was speeding. From the record provided, we cannot review the factual decisions of the District Court, *Westleigh v. Conger*, 2000 ME 134, ¶ 2, 755 A.2d 518, 519; *Int'l Paper Realty Corp. v. St. Hilaire*, 525 A.2d 1035, 1036 (Me. 1987), and we discern no error of law.
