MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The paternal grandfather of Beronica and Amanda L. appeals from an order entered in the District Court (Portland, *Lawrence, J.*) denying his second motion to intervene in pending child protective proceedings against Beronica and Amanda's mother and father. Contrary to the grandfather's contentions, the court did not exceed the bounds of its discretion in denying his motion to intervene. *See* 22 M.R.S.A. § 4005-B (Supp. 2001); *In re Annie A.*, 2001 ME 105, ¶ 26 & nn.7, 8, 774 A.2d 378, 385 & nn.7, 8.
