MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Veronica Gorlovsky appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (York, *Janelle, J.*) finding that Gorlovsky operated a motor vehicle in excess of the maximum speed limit, pursuant to 29-A M.R.S. § 2073(3) (2006). She contends that the court's decision is contrary to the evidence, but she did not submit a transcript as required by M.R. App. P. 5(b)(2)(A). Nor did she submit an appendix as required by M.R. App. P. 8(a). Her failure to follow the Rules of Appellate Procedure prevents any meaningful appellate review and thus requires that we dismiss the appeal. *See* M.R. App. P. 4(c), 8(j).
